Missed Registration – What Next?

October 2018: You will need to complete and return your Common Application Form in October to your Local Authority (Gloucestershire County Council or other if you live outside Gloucestershire). You can include Grammar Schools on this Common Application Form if you wish. However, your son/daughter will not be considered for a grammar place until after they have received their test result. Alternatively, you can use your five choices for other schools, and then be considered for a grammar school place once your son /daughter has their results.

Friday 1st March 2019: National Allocation Day is on Friday 1st March. Your son/daughter will be allocated a secondary school (not a grammar school) based on your preferences on the Common Application Form. If you live in Gloucestershire you should also receive details on how to be considered during the waiting list round.

After 1st March but BEFORE Friday 8th March 2019: You will need to contact Gloucestershire Local Authority and complete the Waiting list common application form. This form will be available on the Gloucestershire Local Authority website.

Late March 2019: Providing you have completed the above form with Gloucestershire local authority, your son/daughter will be offered the opportunity to sit the post-allocation entrance test at Pate's or any of the other grammar schools. Your son/daughter will be placed on the waiting list (providing they have met the qualifying standard) in rank order and will be included in the waiting list process. Gloucestershire Local Authority will notify you if your son/daughter is offered a place at their chosen grammar school.

After 29th March 2019: This is the end of the post allocation process at which point final allocations are confirmed. After this date, if places are declined, we then go back to the waiting list and offer places in rank order. This is when your son/daughter may be offered a place. Based on previous years, we usually have places declined.

April 2019: If you have not been allocated a place, then you are able to appeal. Appeals are usually heard in May/June. Please refer to our website for our Admissions and Appeals policies www.patesgs.org.
