



Pate's Grammar School Parents' Association 100 Club Information

The 100 Club has always been a very good method of raising funds. The club is open to parents of current pupils and staff members of Pate's Grammar School and any parents of former pupils, who joined the club while their children attended the school.

This letter explains how the 100 Club operates, please keep for future reference. The club rules are attached.

How much does it cost?

Each share costs **£5**, payable monthly over a 12 month period, on the first day of the month. There is no start or finish date to the scheme, so you can join at any time (minimum 12 months).

How do I pay?

Payment is by standing order, on the first day of the month, £5 monthly, (minimum 12 months) or an annual standing order of **£60**.

How does it work?

There will be a monthly draw for one prize of **£100**, with a bonus draw of **£1000** in June. However, the committee shall have absolute discretion to reduce the amount payable in prizes should membership drop to an unacceptable level.

Currently, we have in excess of 100 members who are split equally between two clubs, both offering the same prizes. All prize winners are notified in writing and a list of winners is posted on the school website patesgs.org found under the Pate's Grammar School Parents' Association tab.

What do I do now?

New numbers are now available, and we would like to invite you to join the 100 Club, but remember that membership is limited, so fill out your application soon to avoid disappointment. You can choose to increase your chances by purchasing more than one monthly share.

Should you wish to join, please complete the Membership application form and Standing Order Mandate and return both forms to: **Pate's Grammar School Parents' Association 100 Club**, c/o Pate's Grammar School, Princess Elizabeth Way, Cheltenham, Gloucestershire, GL51 0HG.

A number will then be allocated and the Standing Order Mandate forwarded to your bank. You will be advised in writing of your membership number. The first monthly payment will be taken on the first day of the following month.

If two or more consecutive payments are missed, it will be assumed that the membership has lapsed and we will write to you to confirm this.

Any amendments to this letter or to the membership rules will be notified in writing to all members.
