KS3

Year 7

In PDC there are lessons looking at what is in a cigarette and exploring the human impact of the tobacco industry.

Year 8

In PDC there are three lessons providing age-appropriate knowledge about substance use and the understanding and skills to manage influences young people experience in relation to tobacco, alcohol and other drugs.

Year 9

In TPM sessions on County Lines are delivered through Gloucestershire Safeguarding Children Partnership immersive play, as well as through our SchoolBeat officer.

KS4

In the FLD programme students explore the impact of drug and alcohol use.

Sixth form

The Information, Advice and Guidance programme (IAG) threads through both Years 12 and 13 and delivers specific sessions relating to Drugs and Alcohol. Sessions are tailored to the challenges facing Sixth Form students and, wherever possible, are delivered by experts in the field.

In Year 12, a session on 'Safe Nights Out' is delivered early in the Autumn Term.

A representative from Gloucestershire Constabulary also delivers separate sessions on Drug Awareness and on Alcohol Awareness.
