



Pate's Grammar School Parents' Association 100 Club Rules

- 1 The club shall be known as Pate's Parents' Association 100 Club.
- 2 The purpose of the Pate's Grammar School Parents' Association 100 club is to raise funds to support the school.
- 3 The club will be run under the supervision of the Pate's Parents' Association who also administer the Club.
- 4 The Club is open to parents of current pupils and staff members of Pate's Grammar School and any parents of former pupils who joined the 100 club whilst their children attended the school.
- 5 As there is no start or finish date new membership will commence on receipt of confirmation of the first payment for a minimum of 12 months.
- 6 Members must be 16 and over and complete an application form. Members may have and are encouraged to apply for one or multiple numbers.
- 7 The 100 Club shall not be restricted to 100 members.
- 8 Entry will be by subscription of £5 per month by standing order for a **minimum of 12 months** paid on the first of each month.
- 9 The draw will be monthly. Drawn in arrears at the appropriate Committee meeting or School event. (August will be drawn at the first available date in the new academic year).
- 10 Winners will be contacted by email following the draw.
- 11 The prize will be £100 per month for 11 months with a bonus draw of £1,000 in June.
- 12 Registers will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them. Any change of address or bank details should be notified in writing to Pate's Parents' Association 100 Club via the school address.
- 13 Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the Club if their renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of two months.
- 14 Unallocated numbers will be deemed to be allocated to Pate's Grammar School, any prizes drawn from this allocation will remain in the 100 Club and be paid to the Pate's Grammar School in September each year.
- 15 Committee shall have absolute discretion to reduce the amount payable in prizes should membership drop to an unacceptable level. The Committee may amend or vary these Rules at any time and in any way in which they see fit, so long as any such amendment or variation is considered to be in the best interests of the club. Any amendments will be notified to members in writing.
