

Parents Trip Policy

Ethos and Rationale:

Pate's recognises that pupils derive immense educational benefit by taking part in off-site visits which provide essential learning opportunities from first hand experiences. Such trips can not only develop pupil understanding in a real world context but can enhance the development of personal and social skills. The knowledge and experience gained beyond the classroom can consolidate and extend the taught curriculum within it. We classify our trips into two categories 'Core Curriculum Trips' and 'Enrichment Trips'. Further details about the differences between these two can be found below.

Practicalities:

Details of trips that we are offering as a school are always emailed to parents and students to minimise the need for hard copies. *Please note; all trips will depart from school and arrive back at school.*

Trips Within The UK – Non Residential

- All students who wish to take part require the following;
 - Payment to be made via 'School Gateway' to secure place/ticket especially where limited places/tickets are available.
 - Parental consent on line via 'School Gateway'.
 - Contact and Student medical details to be checked on line (help sheet attached).

Residential Trips/UK and Abroad

- All students who wish to take part are required to complete the following which will be available once the trip has been launched and sent to parents;
 - Payment via 'School Gateway' to secure place/ticket.
 - Details Form, consent is given as part of this form.
 - Passport Information sheet where required. (sent after launch to relevant students)
 - Code of Conduct Form (sent 2 weeks before trip to relevant students)

Over-Subscription

- We will always ensure that trips that are a 'Core Curriculum Trip' can accommodate every pupil in the year group who wishes to attend.
- However, for practical and health and safety reasons it is sometimes NOT always possible for every pupil to attend every 'Enrichment Trip' that is offered – it would be impractical and unsafe for example to take 150 students year 7 students to France each year.

- In the above circumstances, to ensure equality for all, a 'names out of a hat' approach (once the closing date has passed) will be taken. Students will NOT be allocated places on a 'first come, first served basis'.
- All students are guaranteed a Language trip in KS3
- Ski Trips can also be oversubscribed and again priority is given to those students who have applied previously but who have been unsuccessful in earlier years.
- No 'cross departmental' priority system is operated, only for similar trips within departments.

We make no guarantee that trips previously run will run each year, however for information a list of trips offered is attached.
